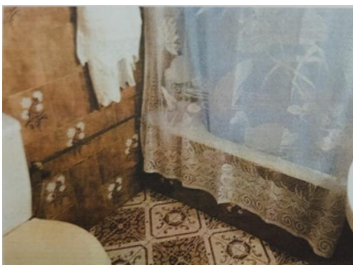

These pink-hued lagoons, now part of a natural park, are not only a unique sight but also home to flamingos and other wildlife. Torrevieja has undergone major transformations in recent years, including a modernized marina and harbour area, now lined with stylish waterfront restaurants, boutique shops, and scenic promenades.
