This 96-m2 house is set in half a hectare of land (over an acre) in an idyllic location just 1 kilometre from the charming village of Collado but in a very private location. It has wonderful views of the nearby Gredos mountains. The house has a large living-dining-kitchen area with a wood stove as well as 3 bedrooms and 2 bathrooms. There is a large porch on three sides of the house so you could have breakfast in the morning sunshine and lunch in the shade. Only 24 km from the famous monastery at Cuacos de Yuste, to which Charles V, Holy Roman Emperor and King of Spain, retired to in 1556. It was his son Phillip II who sent the ill-fated Spanish Armada to invade England.
