Around the corner from the house is the well-known Harry's bar, a great place for drinks and food. And right next to Harry's is the Quesada municipal swimming pool - where residents can swim for free and non-residents pay just a few euros. And, being right by the bar, it is a perfect place to spend the whole day.

The house itself has two bedrooms, one on the ground floor and the master bedroom upstairs. You do need to walk through the downstairs bedroom to get to the stairs. The master bedroom has its own ensuite and there are two more bathrooms - on on the ground floor and one in the underbuild. The underbuild provides a handy storage area and is accessed from the front garden.

There is plenty of outside space to enjoy the Spanish sunshine, with a garden and two enclosed terraces - all with amazing views.

You also have your own private parking space opposite the property.

Ciudad Quesada is one of the most sought after locations on the Costa Blanca. Since its inception in the 1970s (after local entrepreneur, Justo Quesada, decided to build his own 'city'), it has grown into a bustling town with a busy high street lined by shops, bars and restaurants, its own town hall and even a golf course. It is home to people of all nationalities and has English and Norwegian schools.

Quesada is ideally located, just ten minutes from the golden sand beaches of Guardamar Del Segura and only 30 minutes from Alicante airport. The beach town of Torrevieja is about 15 minutes by car and the beaches of Orihuela Costa a few minutes more. Zenia Boulevard shopping centre is also within easy reach.
