Street side: burglarproof sun proof glass, aluminium shutters with remote control.

The building has a solid finish with false ceilings, fitted lighting fixtures, a sound system, air conditioning and heating. lighting, sound system, fire protection with emergency lighting, alarm system and air conditioning hot and cold. Walls in plaster, granite tiles brand Porcelanosa. Separate sanitary facilities for men and women in each room are adapted for wheelchair users. Exterior aluminium joinery with double glazing 2x6mm, sliding windows, electric aluminium shutters with remote control.
